



Board Meeting

Minutes

- The meeting was called to order by Ron Knaus at 5:02pm.

- The July meeting minutes were approved for publication.
- Sam Azinger gave the Treasurers Report and stated that the TBA continues to be in good financial shape. With most of the revenue coming from the Village Market vendors and sponsors. Rob Kos reported that our revenue is down about 50% at our Traveling Food Truck Tour events. While revenue is down, the TBA feels it important to continue doing the events in order to continue to establish it.
- Status of events:
 - Traveling Food Truck Tour – The next event is August 20, and we are looking for volunteers to help serve beverages. Revenue from the June & July events were down about 50%. But we believe that it is important to maintain the series.
 - Best Dam Blues Fest – Sept. 19 & 20 – The committee decided to postpone the event until Sept. 18 & 19, 2021. It is not the right time to launch a new event.
 - Business Trick or Treat – This event will happen on Oct. 29, 2020, but the TBA will issue guidelines for businesses and participants to follow. Rob Kos and Sam Azinger will work up a draft for the TBA Board to review at the September meeting.
 - Nightmare on Elm Street – This event will be postponed until 2021. It is not the right time to launch a new event.

 - Volunteers are needed for the Aug, 20 Food Truck Tour
